SOWING/GROWING Sow April-June in a cold frame or cold greenhouse 3mm (1/8") deep in trays of a good quality seed compost. Prick off seedlings when large enough to handle, grow on and harden off for planting out in September. Alternatively, sow seeds directly into a finely prepared seedbed in May-June. Keep soil moist until the seedlings appear. Best in a sunny or slightly shaded position.

NOTE - Seeds/plants toxic if eaten

HEIGHT APPROX. 60-120cm (2-4') HARDY PERENNIAL Flowers year after year
