How to grow your beetroot...

- 1 Choose a sunny spot in the garden with weed-free soil. Dig and rake the soil to a fine crumbly surface.
- 2 Using the corner of a hoe or rake draw a groove into moist soil.
- 3 Roll out the tape along the groove.
- 4 Cover with soil. Keep the soil moist. Watch your beetroot grow — it's *GrowEasy!*
- 5 Thin the seedlings to around 2.5–5cm (1–2") apart. (You can use the thinnings for salads).

- If growing more than one row, allow 30cm (12") between rows.
- For a constant supply of beetroot sow at two weekly intervals.
- Remember, you can cut the tape to suit row length.
- Cook quickly to preserve vitamins.
