#### sowing & growing

Sow thinly March-July into finely raked, warm, moist soil at a depth of 13mm (½") in rows 30cm (12") apart. Thin seedlings to 15cm (6") between plants. Germination can take up to 21 days. Can also be sown February onwards in a propagator on a windowsill or in a greenhouse at approx 10°-15°C (50°-60°F). Transplant seedlings when large enough into 50mm (2") pots, grow on and finally plant out. Grows best in well cultivated soil in a shady spot.

**quality control:** This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
