sowing & growing

Sow in pots or trays on a windowsill or in a greenhouse using a good quality compost. Cover seeds with 25mm (1") compost. Grow on, planting outside or protecting with cloches or 'fleece' until frost risk has passed, 20cm (8") between plants. Alternatively sow direct into prepared, warm, moist soil at a depth of 38mm (1½"), thinning as necessary to 20cm (8") between plants. Allow 60cm (24") between rows. Grows best in rich soil in a sunny position, pods well held above soil. Use an organic based fertiliser. Water freely as pods swell.

quality control: This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
