Exotic Kohl Rabi  
The Turnip/Cabbage

This variety adds great colour to the ornamental vegetable garden. It is named from the German *kohl* for cabbage and *rabi* for turnip. Grate raw into salads to add a nutty flavour or sauté in butter. Delicious!

**How to grow:** Sow the seeds thinly 1cm (½") deep into a warm, moist, weed-free soil in rows about 40cm (15") apart. Germination should take 7-10 days. Thin the resultant seedlings to 15cm (6") apart. Harvest when the roots are between golf ball and tennis ball size. Water well during periods of dry weather. For successional crops throughout the summer, make additional sowings at 3 week intervals. Plant tops may be used like cabbage and swollen roots for soups and salads.
