SOWING AND GROWING

Sow in pots or trays on a windowsill or in a greenhouse using a good quality compost. Cover seeds with 38mm (1½") compost (Germination 7-14 days). Grow on, planting outside or protecting with cloches until frost risk has passed. Alternatively, sow direct into prepared, warm, moist soil, first erecting canes or netting to eventually support plants, sowing one seed per cane or at 15-23cm (6-9") intervals along the row at a depth of 50mm (2"). Grows best in rich, well prepared soil. Conserve moisture by mulching with manure, straw or a layer of grass clippings.

Sowing → Cropping – 10-12 weeks.

HEALTHY EATING Freeze soon after harvest for maximum nutrient retention.



Quality Control: This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
