SOWING AND GROWING

For early crops, sow in pots or trays on a windowsill or in a greenhouse using a good quality compost. Cover seeds with 38mm (1½") compost (Germination 7-14 days). Grow on, planting outside or protecting with cloches until frost risk has passed, 20cm (8") between plants.

Alternatively sow direct from late April into prepared, warm, moist soil at a depth of 50mm (2"), thinning as necessary to 20cm (8") between plants. Allow 60cm (24") between rows. Grows best in rich, well prepared soil in a sunny position. Water well during dry weather. For winter use, pull plants and allow seed to dry in a cool airy place. Dried seeds for winter use should be stored in airtight jars.

Sowing → Cropping – 9-12 weeks.

HEALTHY EATING
