

# Mr & Mrs Pot

## GROWING INSTRUCTIONS

### On Receipt

Remove the plants from the packaging straight away. Check the compost is adequately moist and water if necessary. Take the 2 feet from inside the pot and attach to the saucer on the bottom of the pot. Once Mr/Mrs Pot has been assembled, we recommend using a good quality, free draining soil based compost or alternatively a general purpose potting compost. Fill the pot to within 2.5cm (1") of the top of the pot, then make evenly spaced holes in the compost, just in from the edge of the pot. The holes should be of a size which will allow the top of the compost to be level with that of the compost round the roots of the plant. Once your plants have been safely planted, place the Mr/Mrs Pot in a warm sheltered situation outside and apply a gently sprinkling of water to settle them into their new home. The compost should be kept moist but not over wet through the growing season, and once the plants are established feed regularly with a liquid flowering plant or tomato fertiliser.

**For Mr Bean:** Allow the flowers to mature and pick the beans once they reach approximately the length of a pencil.

**For Mr Tomato:** Allow the shoots to develop and flower picking the fruit when it has matured to a rich red colour.

**For Mrs Sunflower:** Allow the flowers to develop and once they have died back in the autumn lay out the flowers for the birds winter food.

**For Mrs Sweet Pea:** Once the flower blooms start to fade these should be removed to encourage more flowers.

**For Mrs Pansy Pot:** Remove faded flowers to encourage more to develop. Only apply feed during warm weather.
